- 6. Describe the work completed, number of windows & doors installed
- Certification of each window and door including:
 - a. Brand & Model # for all windows and doors

OR

- b. NRCan reference # or Certified Products Directory (CPD#) provided by one of the following certifying bodies:
 - Canadian Standards Association (CSA);
 - ii. Intertek Canada (Intertek);
 - iii. Labtest Certification (LC);
 - iV. National Fenestration Ratings Council (NFRC)

AND

- c. Metric U-Factor rating (W/m²-K) of each window and door
- 8. Total Labour cost
- Participant Energy Savings Plan eligibility code (ESP1, ESP2 or ESP3)
- 10. Invoice & Rebate calculation
- 11. Balance due = Participant Portion
