


CleanBC Better Homes and Home Renovation Rebate Programs Invoice Requirements

You must have an invoice from your utility and an electrical contractor invoice for the electrical service upgrade rebate. The utility provider invoice needs to have all the information identified below in order to meet the program documentation requirements.
